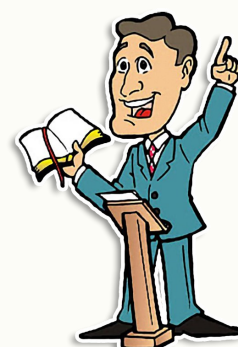

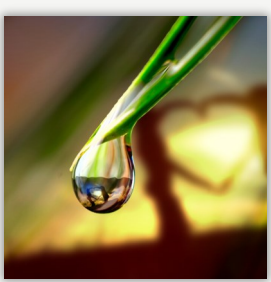
- **Glenys** and **Andy** have let us know the particular goods they are short of so that they can maintain the same quality of goods in every parcel they send out.

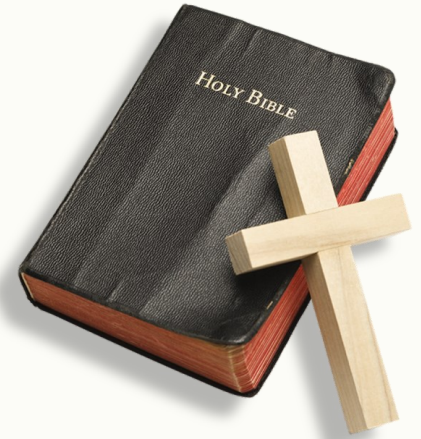

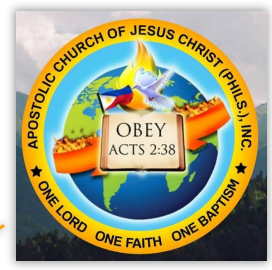
